VINCENT E. TABER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

GUIDELINES AND QUALIFICATIONS

The Vincent E. Taber Memorial Scholarship is an award made annually to a qualified student based on the following guidelines and qualifications:

- 1. One scholarship award in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) will be made annually as long as sufficient funds are available in the account.
- 2. The Regional Board of Directors/ executive committee will review applications and make the final decision as to the recipient.
- 3. Preference will be given to students of need accepted at Berkshire Institute for Christian Studies. Award monies will be directly applied to student's account.
- 4. The application must be received by September 15th of any year and the award will be made prior to the start of the school year.

Qualifications

- 1. The applicant must be a member in good standing of an Advent Christian Church or other evangelical church.
- 2. The applicant must be of sound Christian character and provide a letter of recommendation from his/her pastor.
- 3. The applicant must provide a brief statement of personal testimony and sense of call to Christian service.
- 4. The applicant must be able to demonstrate financial need by providing information on anticipated annual costs along with expected sources of income.
- 5. The applicant must provide a transcript of last completed year of schooling.
